

Terms and Conditions – Cityscape Global AI Prompt-a-thon Challenge 2025 (the “Terms”)

1 Background

1.1 Cityscape Global is the organiser of the Cityscape Global AI Prompt-a-thon 2025 (“the Competition”), a competition designed to show the applications of OpenAI to the Real Estate Development Market. The Competition is conducted in accordance with these Terms.

2 Competition objectives

2.1 The objective of the Competition is to identify and give visibility to teams using prompting and OpenAI within the three rounds of the live competition.

2.2 The Competition culminates in live teams at Cityscape Global 2025 in Riyadh, with the aim of awarding the winning team with industry-wide recognition.

3 Participants

3.1 There are no territorial limitations to participate.

3.2 The organiser reserves the right to disqualify any participant who: (i) disrupts the Competition, (ii) is involved in unlawful or unethical practices, (iii) breaches any applicable laws or these Terms, (iv) or behaves in a way that could negatively impact the Competition or Cityscape Global.

3.3 Participants may be subject to due diligence at any time. The organiser may request supporting documents to confirm compliance.

4 Registration

4.1 Participation is free and does not constitute any legal relationship between the organiser and participants beyond these Terms.

4.2 Applications must be submitted through the official Cityscape Global platform during the submission window. The application must: (i) accept these Terms and the applicable Privacy Policy, (ii) provide accurate and complete information in English, (iii) include relevant supporting materials. Late or incomplete entries will not be accepted. The organiser is not responsible for technical issues or disputes between team members.

5 Participants' obligations

5.1 Submissions must be original and owned by the participant. By entering, participants confirm they own or have the right to submit the information and materials provided.

5.2 Participants must not infringe any third-party rights or breach any applicable laws. Participants agree to indemnify the organiser against any claims arising from their submission or participation.

5.3 All submitted materials must:

- Be truthful and accurate;
- Not infringe on any rights;
- Not contain unlawful, defamatory, or harmful content;
- Not promote discrimination or violence;
- Not cause harm to persons or property.

6 Liability

6.1 Participants shall indemnify and hold harmless the organiser and its affiliates from any claims arising from their participation.

6.2 Views expressed by speakers or organisers during the Competition are their own and should not be relied upon as official advice.

6.3 To the maximum extent permitted by law, the organiser and its affiliates shall not be liable for any indirect, incidental, or consequential damages, including but not limited to loss of profit, revenue, data, or goodwill.

6.4 Participation in the Competition, including the on-site semifinals and finals, does not guarantee business outcomes or commercial engagements. Attendance is voluntary and at the sole discretion and expense of the participant.

7 Intellectual Property

7.1 By entering, participants agree that prompts, ideas, and outputs shared during the competition may be displayed publicly and used for event promotion.

7.2 Participants retain rights to their own work but grant the organisers a non-exclusive right to record, share, and publish competition content.

8 Personal data

8.1 Personal data collected will be processed in accordance with the Cityscape Global Privacy Policy. Participants must ensure any third-party data shared has appropriate consent.

9 Competition process

9.1 The Competition consists of the following stages:

Phase 1 – Application: Applications open September and closes in October

Phase 2 – Screening: Cityscape Global will screen applications and select the four competing teams based on the criteria in Section 10.1

Phase 3 – Live Competition: Competition will take place 17 November 2025.

9.2 All logistics, including travel, accommodation, and any associated participation costs, are the sole responsibility of the participant. Participation in the Competition, including attending the Competition at Cityscape Global, is undertaken at the participant's discretion and risk. The organiser does not guarantee any commercial engagements, partnerships, or outcomes as a result of participation.

9.3 The organiser reserves the right to amend the schedule or structure at any time.

10 Selection criteria

10.1 Judging Criteria for Finalists

Judges will evaluate all eligible Submissions against the following weighted criteria (the "Criteria") based on the applicant's two required elements:

a. Prompt Efficacy: The demonstrated technical ingenuity and effectiveness of the Prompt in creating a specific, high-quality, and valuable output, confirming its potential as a repeatable solution.

b. Persuasiveness of Rationale: The clarity, coherence, and strength of the applicant's written justification, strictly adhering to the 250-word limit, including how their skills and approach align with the goals of the challenge.

These criteria apply to the selection of finalists during Phase 2. Live competition judging criteria will be provided to finalists separately.

10.2 Judge's Determination

Judges will apply the Criteria set forth in Clause 10.1 to determine participants.

Notwithstanding the application of the Criteria, the selection and ranking of all Participants and Winners shall be at the sole and absolute discretion of the Judges. The Judges' determination in all matters relating to the Challenge, including the interpretation of these Terms and Conditions and the application of the Criteria, is final and binding, and no correspondence will be entered into regarding the scoring, deliberations, or outcomes.

11 Acceptance of the Terms

11.1 By applying, participants fully accept these Terms.

12 Amendments and cancellation

12.1 The organiser reserves the right to amend these Terms or cancel the Competition at any time. Continued participation implies acceptance of updated Terms.

13 Applicable Law and Jurisdiction

13.1 These Terms are governed by the laws of the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia.

13.2 All disputes shall be submitted to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of Riyadh, Saudi Arabia.
